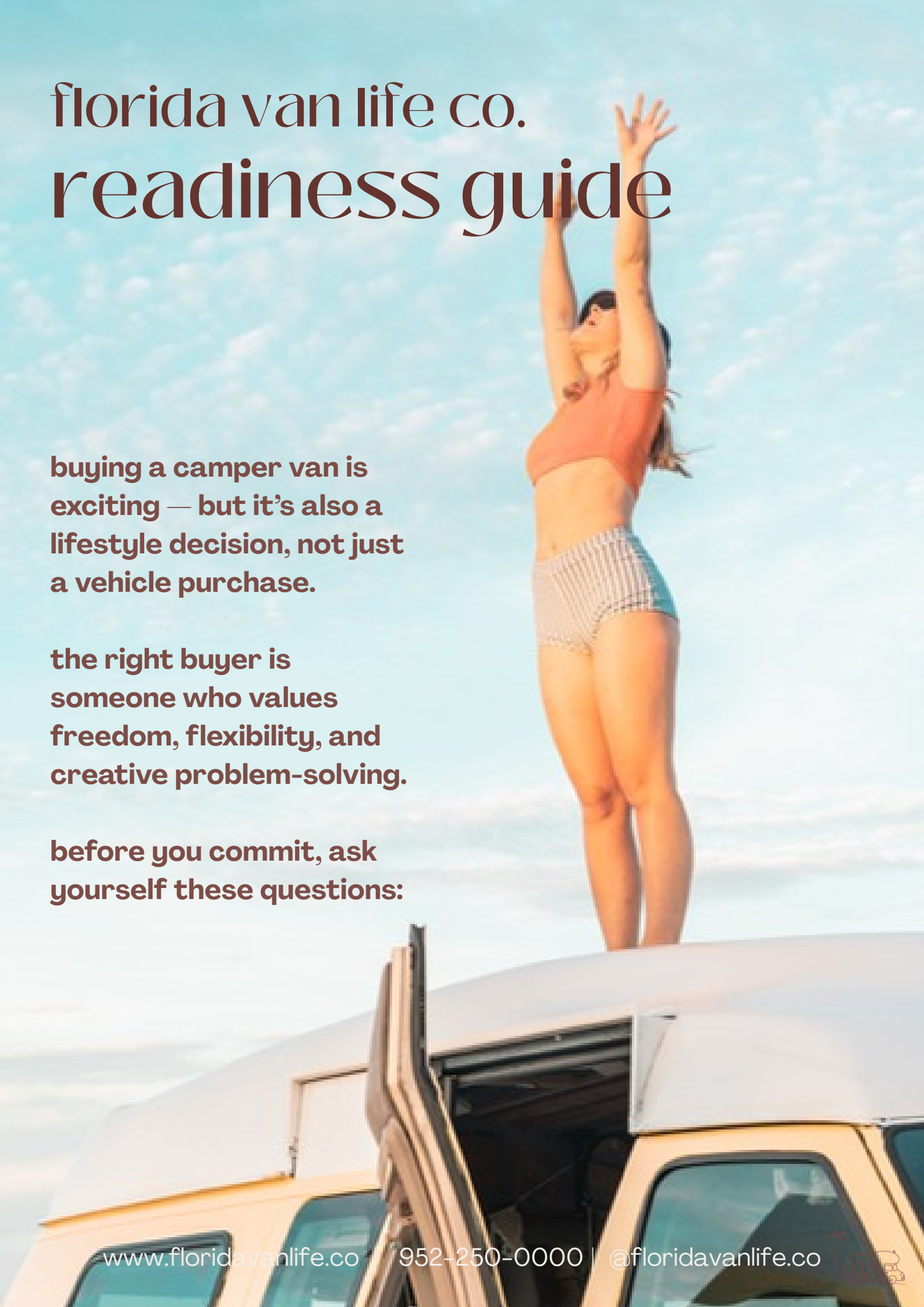


10 questions to ask before buying a camper van

question 7

do I feel confident driving and parking a larger vehicle?

question 9

do I value sustainability?

question 10
