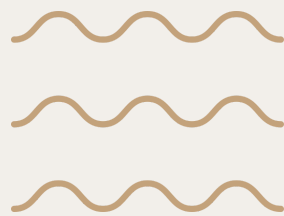

BEACHES

Saint Pete Beach

Voted as the #1 beach in the U.S.A., this beach attracts visitors and locals alike. Step into historic Don Cesar hotel for a sunset drink or three.

Upham Beach

Estelle's go-to beach! When she's in town, you can find her catching sunsets here. Walk all the way to the right to find the Secret Garden.

Treasure Island

Check out the drum circle here across from the Publix grocery store every Sunday afternoon. After sunset the drum circle becomes a silent disco.

Pass-a-Grille Dog Beach

A place for both you and your furry friend to play and relax.

Fort de Soto State Park

This State Park has amazing beaches, a fishing pier, and an old fort to explore. Entrance fee \$5.

Maderia Beach

Just 10 minutes from The Dome, this beach is the easiest for a quick sunset before grabbing dinner or drinks.

PLACES + EVENTS

Vinoy Park

A local favorite. Events, art, festivals, and concerts are held here most weekends. Sit by the seawall at sunset as you may catch a glimpse of local wild dolphins fishing for dinner.

Saint Pete Pier

Located right next to Vinoy Park, this is a highlight of Saint Pete. Great for all ages, check out the playground, food, or free trolley to take you to the end and back.

Saturday Morning Market

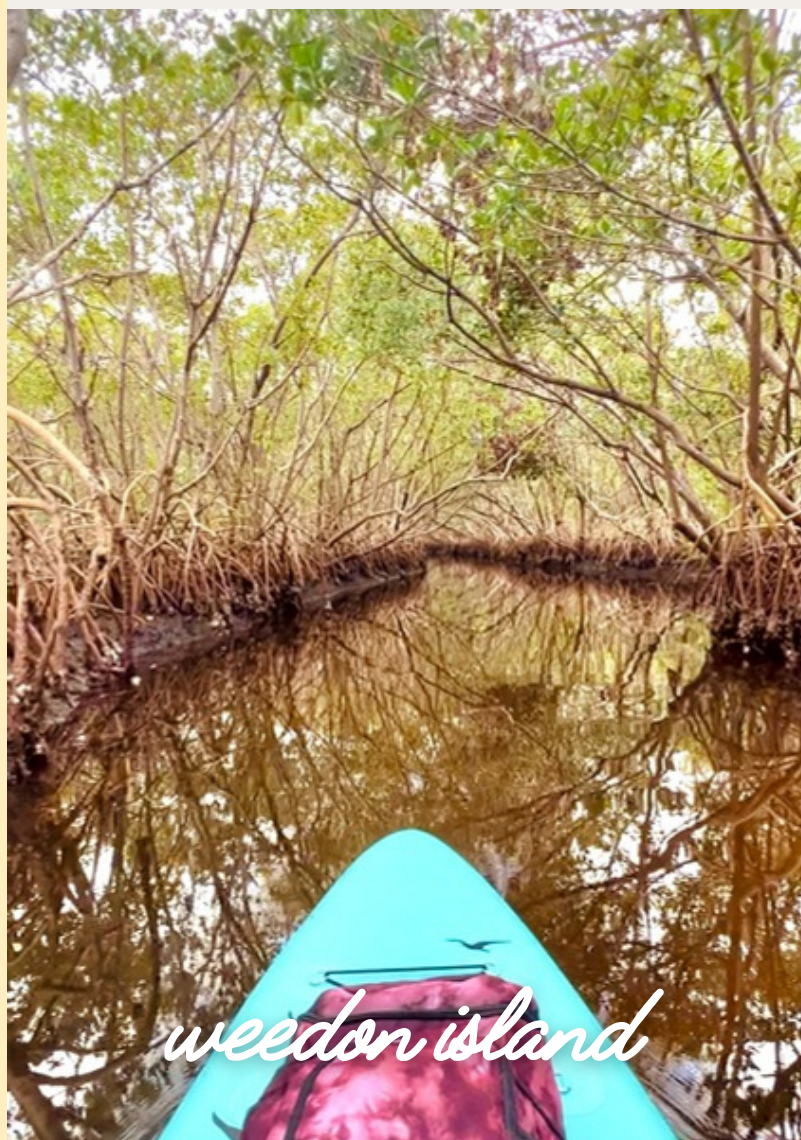
Every Saturday there's a morning market in downtown Saint Pete with fresh food, live music, artists vending, and more.

Sunset Cruise

Take a sunset cruise to Shell Key to find shells and enjoy sunset on the water.

Weedon Island

Rent kayaks or SUPs and launch from the Weedon Island Pier for a trip through the mangroves. You might see flying fish, manatees, dolphins, or tiny black crabs. Water depth depends on tide height. Typically, mornings are best to complete the full four mile paddle loop.
